

# Rhi's three beats Spurs

RHI Gladman scored a hat-trick in Hampstead Womens' 6-0 demolition of Tottenham Hotspur thirds to book their place in the semi-final of the Russell Cup for the first time in the club's history.

Val Toro opened the scoring when she latched on to a perfectly-weighted Char Blackmore through-ball, before rocketing it into the top left corner of the net, from 18 yards out.

Skipper Gladman lobbed Spurs defence and keeper from 35 yards for their second goal.

Toro then cleverly back-heeled on the edge of the area, split Tottenham's defence, leaving Blackmore to side-foot the ball into the net from six yards.

In the 59th minute Gladman sent Toro free down the left flank who whipped in a tantalising cross to Claire Arnold at the back post. Arnold unselfishly passed to the

unmarked Gladman to score and join Arnold on 13 goals for the season.

Central defender Zena Coffey headed home a Toro corner on 75 minutes before Gladman claimed her second hat-trick of the season, from the penalty spot in the 90th minute.
